



7. Remove backing from "Give Thanks" rub-on and use popsicle stick to transfer image to center of 1" x 3" Pattern 3b DSP.

Tear both short edges about 1/4 from rub-on greeting.



8. Tear short ends off of 1-1/4" x 4" Pattern 2a DSP so that it is about 1/2" longer than the DSP with the rub-on.

Sponge all edges of the three pieces with Dusty Durango ink.



9. Carefully cut out around the leafy branch shown on the rub-ons Template.



10. Remove backing from the leafy branch rub-on and use popsicle stick to transfer image onto the tag. Place rub on so that branch begins at, or off, the bottom left corner, and the top splits around the bottom of the "T" in Thanks.



11. Lay an 8" long Rich Razzleberry Polka-Dot ribbon out, polka-dot side down so it looks like a "support a cause" ribbon.

Slide both ends into back side of the slot punched into the tag.



12. Pull ribbon through so only an inch or so of the loop end remains. Tuck the ends of the ribbon through the loop.

Gently pull ribbon ends to tighten loop. Add a small amount of SNAIL under the top of loop to keep it from loosening.



13. Adhere tag to card front at an angle using SNAIL.

Trim ribbon ends to about 1 1/4" long with scissors.



14. The completed card is bursting with warm colors and gratitude and is sure to warm the heart of whoever receives it.



15. If using the Whisper White rub-ons your finished card will look like this.
